

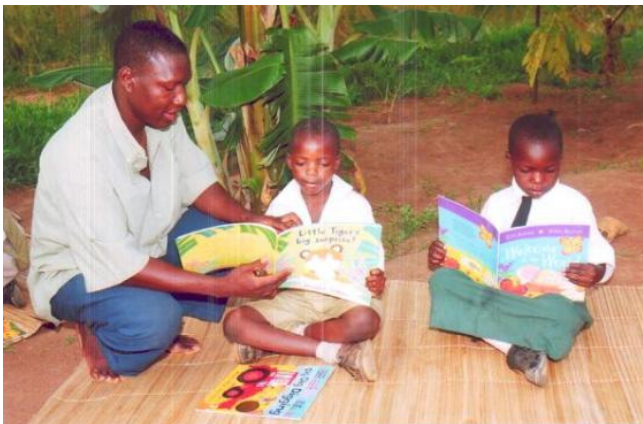


Dear Everyone,

At the end of this month Japhet wrote to tell me that his Father had been taken into hospital and is diagnosed with TB (Tuberculosis). We pray that he will respond to the medication he is being given and will soon be feeling well again.

The school holidays start on 5th June until 10th July in Tanzania so goodness knows what the children will get up to!!

On 17th June I shall be flying out to Tanzania. I am not leaving the Mchungwa Project behind, but am going to try and help move it forward whilst I am in Tanzania.

I am going to work for an orphanage run by some American people whom I met whilst I was out in Tanzania last year. The orphanage/Children's Centre is called Tumaini and is one of the places where some of the older children from Forever Angels, (where I volunteered last year) go once they reach 5/6 years old. So I shall meet some of the children again, but in a different setting. I shall be nearer to Japhet and the children too (nearer by about 5,000 miles)! and I shall have the opportunity to visit them and hopefully get some building work done with the donations we have received from the website. ***On that note may I tell you that we have a new bank account set up for receiving donations/sponsorship by standing order.
